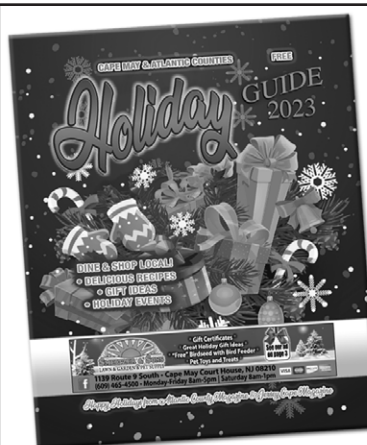

The Lighthouse Challenge of New Jersey is an annual event that takes place the third weekend of October each year. The challenge is to visit 11 lighthouse sites, 3 lifesaving stations, and 1 museum over the two day weekend. The challenge route covers the Atlantic Coast from Sandy Hook to Cape May and the Delaware Bay and River Coast from Cape May to Paulsboro. Take the challenge and learn more about these historic treasures of New Jersey. A small registration fee enables you to collect a souvenir from each site. Please join us for a fun family weekend.

Regarding East Point Lighthouse - Latest News - For the last 50 years, the East Point Lighthouse has been under the care of the Maurice River Historical Society. The Society has restored, furnished and maintained the Lighthouse for the enjoyment of the public, with tours and activities during the year. In September, the NJ Department of Environmental Protection, which is supposed to care for state owned historic sites, declined to renew the lease for the lighthouse with the Society. The DEP then closed the lighthouse. The DEP has indicated that they will reopen the lighthouse at some point, but here is no specific date. The Maurice River Historical Society will still maintain a check point for East Point on the Challenge, as well as the check point for the Delaware Bay Lights, at Leechester Hall in Leesburg (Dorchester). The Hall is actually much closer to Route 47 and not too far from the road to the lighthouse. The exact address is 548 Main St, Leesburg NJ 08327. (Your GPS may list it as Dorchester.) You may still visit the lighthouse, since it is on public land, but it most likely will not be open to the public.

How do I register for the Challenge? There is no pre-registration. You register at the site where you start and you can start at any of the sites. It only takes a few minutes. We ask for your home state and how many are in your party. And then, of course, we collect your registration fee.

What does it cost to participate in the Challenge? The cost is \$5 to register. For that, you'll get your souvenir holder, this year a booklet to collect silver stamps for our 25th Challenge. There is no other cost unless you decide to climb the lighthouses. Some of the lighthouses do charge a fee to climb. (Children 11 and under are free to climb with an adult.)

Do I have to climb every lighthouse to complete the Challenge? No, climbing is not required. You just have to visit each site. Good for you if you do manage to do that though!

How do you do the Challenge? The object is to visit all the sites on the Challenge. There 11 lighthouse sites, 3 lifesaving stations, and 1 museum. It adds up to 15 sites but only 14 stops since one stop has two lighthouse sites. You have from 8 am on Saturday until 6 pm on Sunday to complete the Challenge. Sites are open from 8 am to 6 pm both days, with 3 sites offering night climbs from 6 to 8 pm on Saturday only. You can start and finish at any of the sites, so you can plan your own route. There is a list of places to stay and places to eat along the way under the Eat & Stay tab in case you decide to stay over Saturday night (or Friday night so you can get an early start).

What happens if I complete the Challenge? If you complete that Challenge, at your last stop, let them know that you've completed. They will check to see if you've visited all the sites. You'll receive a completion sticker and your name will be entered into a drawing for a prize basket filled with lighthouse goodies. There are 3 prizes with the grand prize worth more than \$500.

Finally, a Real Map - For those of you who like to look at maps, us included, here's a map of the sites on the 2024 Challenge. You can view it in Google Maps using this link: shorturl.at/TR0Tk

The 25th Lighthouse Challenge - This year's souvenir is a blue and silver booklet. The booklet contains a brief history of each site, including how many years it's been in operation, as well as a brief history of the Challenge itself. At each stop on the Challenge, you'll collect a silver embossed sticker to place on the page of each site. You'll receive your booklet when you register and at each stop, you'll receive your silver sticker. If you collect all the stickers, you'll be given a completion sticker for your book and you'll be entered in the drawing for our 3 prize baskets. We hope you enjoy celebrating our 25th Lighthouse Challenge with us this year.

SOME CHALLENGE SITES NEARBY

Absecon Lighthouse - New Jersey's tallest lighthouse awaits you at Pacific and Rhode Island Avenues in Atlantic City (walking distance from the Ocean Casino Resort.). Take an amazing journey into time and above it all as you ascend the 228 steps of the Absecon Lighthouse, one of the oldest lighthouses in the country. You'll see breathtaking views of the Atlantic City skyline and up top you'll come face-to-face with the original first-order Fresnel Lens, first lit in 1857. The lighthouse's recent multi-million dollar restoration also includes a stunning replica of the Lightkeeper's dwelling, an educational museum, charming gift shop, Fresnel Lens exhibit in the original Oil House and expansive grounds.

Cape May Lighthouse - The present tower, which is the third documented lighthouse at the southern tip of New Jersey, has always been an attention-getting landmark as well as an aid-to-navigation for mariners. Because it is adjacent to the community of Cape May Point and just two miles from the City of Cape May, it has drawn visitors throughout its history. In 1882, the Cape May Ocean Wave reported that "the gentleman superintendent in charge [of the lighthouse], Mr. Samuel Stillwell, takes pleasure in showing visitors who have the nerve and strength of limb to the top, the interior of the lantern, and explaining the interesting operations of the light. A very picturesque view of the sea, bay, and country may also be obtained from the giddy heights of the edifice."

Tatham Lifesaving Station - Visit the Stone Harbor Life Saving Station, built in 1895, it was recently placed on the national Register of Historic Places. Throughout the facility there are murals and displays outlining this stations heritage to our current Coast Guard. The surf men assigned to this station were the heroes of the American Coast. They routinely risked their lives in maritime rescues. The Life Saving Service was the answer to the most basic question of shipwrecked sailors. Who will help us in our time of greatest need? Climb our tower to observe the vistas of the Atlantic Ocean, Hereford Inlet and the back bays that the surf men continuously monitored for ships in distress. Continuing the theme of serve to our county there are displays and information in our museum depicting activities in our major conflicts since World War I. Of particular interest are artifacts obtained and brought home by our local veterans. We look forward to sharing our treasures with our visitors.

Tuckers Island Light - The Tuckerton Seaport, a working maritime village, is located along the Tuckerton Creek. This one-of-a-kind attraction, in the heart of historic Tuckerton NJ, brings the Jersey Shore's maritime traditions of the past and present to life through people, exhibits and hands-on activities. Discover the Jersey Shore's unique maritime heritage and the interaction between culture and nature on the Barnegat Bay. Experience the rich traditions of the Jersey Shore and its Baymen through the Seaport's recreated and historic buildings, demonstrations, interpretive exhibits, events, festivals, live aquatic displays and more. Decoy carvers, boat builders, basket makers, and baymen entertain, educate and delight visitors of all ages. Stroll the 3/4 mile boardwalk and experience life on the Tuckerton "Crik". Identify birds and plants on our 1/4 mile nature trail. Tour our site and view garveys, sneakboxes, cruising yachts and party boats displayed on land and water.

U.S. Lifesaving Station 30 - This Ocean City station was called Beasley's Station until 1883. Rebuilt in 1885-1886, it is the only U.S. Life Saving Service station left in New Jersey that was rebuilt according to the Service's distinctive 1882-type design. This design is both stunning architecturally, with its gabled roof and lookout tower, and highly effective in the use of space to house both boats and surfmen. In 1905-06, the station was expanded to add a boat bay, a wrap-around porch, and other improvements. The footprint of the building was doubled, and the structure is the only surviving 1882-type station to be expanded according to the historic New Jersey Pattern. In 1915, the U.S. Coast Guard absorbed the U.S. Life Saving Service and assumed control of the Ocean City Station. It is the last of the three stations that were located on the island. The others were the Peck's Beach and Corson's Inlet Stations. The Station passed into private hands in 1945.

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 Nice Size Eel, *Gutted with Head & Skin Left Intact*
- 1-2 Qts. Brine (*Your Choice of Flavor Profile*)
- Oak Wood Chips for Smoking
- Fresh Ground Black Pepper



PREPARATION:

After eel is cleaned and prepared, place it into your favorite brine and refrigerate for 24 hours. Remove eel from brine & rinse with cold water. Dry the eel with paper towels. Season with pepper. Tie a wet string or piece of wet twine around the eel's neck. Hang the eel in the 140° prepared smoker. Smoke until cooked through. Serve as is or with a dipping sauce. I like it plain by itself. Indigenous Peoples' Day is celebrated on the second Monday of October, on October 14 this year, to honor the cultures and histories of the Native American people. The day is centered around reflecting on their tribal roots and the tragic stories that hurt but strengthened their communities.

History of Indigenous Peoples' Day

The first seed of Indigenous Peoples' Day was planted at a U.N. international conference on discrimination in 1977. The first state to recognize the day was South Dakota in 1989. Berkeley, California, and Santa Cruz followed suit. Although the day was still considered Columbus Day up to 1937, many people began calling it Indigenous Peoples' Day to celebrate the rich culture and the lives of Native Americans.

For Native Americans, Columbus Day was always hurtful as it glorified the violent past constituting 500 years of colonial torture and oppression by European explorers like Columbus and those who settled in America. Indigenous Peoples' Day draws attention to the pain, trauma, and broken promises that were erased by the celebration of Columbus Day. Before his arrival, the indigenous folk were successful self-sufficient communities that sustained life for thousands of years.

Year by year, the movement to change Columbus Day to Indigenous Peoples' Day spreads to more and more states, towns, and cities across the United States of America.

Indigenous Peoples' Day celebrates, recognizes, and honors the beautiful traditions and cultures of the Indigenous People, not just in America, but around the world. Their way of life and culture carries wisdom and valuable insights into how we can live life more sustainably.

Today, 14 U.S. states celebrate Indigenous Peoples' Day and not Columbus Day, as well as the District of Columbia. More than 130 cities including Arlington, Amherst, Cambridge, Brookline, Marblehead, Great Barrington, Northampton, Provincetown, Somerville, and Salem also celebrate Indigenous Peoples' Day. Many organizations are seeking to address the lack of access indigenous people have to higher education and have created scholarships to help address this.

How to Celebrate Indigenous Peoples' Day

- **Read indigenous literature** - Some must-read books include "A Short Account of the Destruction of the Indies" by Bartolomé de las Casas, "1491: New Revelations Of The Americas Before Columbus" by Charles C. Mann, "An Indigenous People's History Of The United States" by Roxanne Dunbar-Ortiz, and "Bury My Heart At Wounded Knee" by Dee Brown.
- **Attend an event** - Attend an event hosted by Native Americans or a Native American organization. Learn more about how you can be of assistance with any issues that the group is facing.
- **Host a movie screening** - Watch a movie with your friends and have a discussion afterward. There are a plethora of films to choose from like "Dances with Wolves" (1990), "Songs My Brothers Taught Me" (2015), "Gather" (2020), and "Indian Horse" (2017).

5 Facts About Indigenous Peoples' Day

1. **Female warriors** - Native American women fought alongside men in battles, the most popular among them being the Buffalo Calf Road Woman of the Northern Cheyenne tribe.
2. **Popcorn** - The Indigenous Americans were the first to domesticate the strains of maize that produced popcorn thousands of years ago.
3. **Maria Tallchief** - The first Native American (and American) to dance at the Bolshoi Theatre in Moscow and with the Paris Opera Ballet was Maria Tallchief.
4. **Hockey** - The Native American tribes of Foxes, Saux, and Assiniboine played a game called shinny, which is where hockey came from.
5. **The sequoia tree** - The sequoia tree is named after the revered Cherokee leader Sequoyah, who created an alphabet for his people.

- **It celebrates the original inhabitants** - Indigenous Peoples' Day is a holiday that celebrates the Native Americans, the original inhabitants of North America.

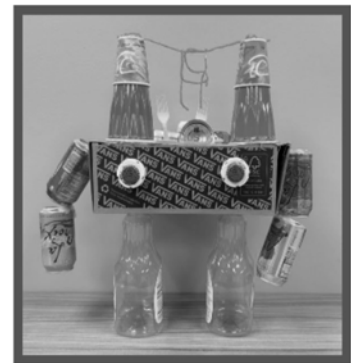

“I’m always proud of him and so proud that he and I are able to really shine with diversity and inclusion. He makes everything go so much smoother,” she said of Cutter, her first Seeing Eye dog.

Sylvia’s job often requires her to travel, including internationally. “I hated traveling for work,” she said. “I hated going to conferences, conventions, graduations, airports – I suffered through them. Now, if it’s the right airport and I know it well enough, I don’t even need assistance anymore. I can work my way through it if it’s one that I know. It’s so liberating, instead of sitting and waiting and being asked if I need a wheelchair. I enjoy the process of travel now.”

Sylvia said she can sense Cutter is slowing down and may retire soon, and Sylvia will return to The Seeing Eye to be matched with her second dog.

“I can appreciate how much these puppy raisers go through giving them back. I am prepared, I knew this would happen, but once it begins to happen it’s super hard,” Sylvia said. “A big thank you to all of the people along the way who are willing to let go so they can go on to do what they need to do, like I do now so he can relax and retire.”
